**COUNCIL
WORKS UPDATE**

Current and soon to be commenced
Council works and projects

Roadworks

The construction crew have finally completed the 4.8km reconstruction of the Western end of the M040 which sees the completion of all upgrades to this road for a while.

Sealing is currently taking place with a new 2 coat seal. The works crew need to be complimented for their outstanding standard of work on this project.

A 1.5km section of the Warralakin Road will also be reconstructed later in March adjacent to Logan Road. Trucks are currently carting excess spoil away from the site at the moment.

A 4km section of Capito Road has been carted and will be levelled and water bound early next week.

New drainage pipes are currently being installed on the Goldfields & 4 Mile Gate Floodways. The existing aluminium pipes have severely corroded and will be replaced with a new recycled plastic pipe which will not be affected by the salt and alkaline soils and water in the area. Traffic in the area are requested to take care with the exposed excavations during the process.

A 4km section of Sth Walgoolan Road near the 6 Mile Clothier intersection will be treated with a polymer product to reduce the amount of corrugation that occurs by heavy traffic in the area.

The maintenance grader is currently at the extreme end to the North grading roads where significant rains fell earlier in the month.

Caravan Park

The town crew are currently redeveloping the caravan park to include an additional 6 bays to accommodate the influx of tourists expected during the tourist season.

Town Development
