Free flu vaccines are available now at Westonia Drs Surgery. People who are eligible for the Free vaccine:

- Pregnant Women (any trimester)
- Persons 65years and older
- Aboriginal People 6mths - 4yr or 15yrs & over
- All children Aged 6mths - 4years

Individuals aged 6 months & over with medical conditions that place them at risk for complications of influenza, namely: Cardiac disease, chronic illnesses requiring regular medical follow -up or hospitalisation in the preceding year, Chronic neurological conditions, people with impaired immunity, children aged 6mths - 10years (receiving long term aspirin Therapy)

The roads crew have completed gravel sheeting Echo Valley Road and have now commenced gravel carting of a 3km section of Daddow Road.

Finally the rain has allowed for Maintenance grading to commence. Initially sections of the Maxfield, Warrachuppin, George and Boodarockin Roads will be graded.

Please remember to use all of the road surface by keeping to the left rather than straight down the middle. With the late start there is every likelihood that not all roads will receive a winter grade this year, so it is important that roads condition be kept in as good order as possible.

HOW DO I .. ? ...report an unsightly property?

We all share a responsibility to keep our own property neat and tidy. This is especially so heading into summer, when long grass and rubbish can pose a fire hazard. Under Council's Local Laws, property owners are required to maintain their properties so they are not unsightly, dangerous or detrimental to the amenity of the neighbourhood. If you have concerns about an unsightly property in your neighbourhood, please contact us. Shire staff will inspect the property and, if found to be unsightly, will ask the property owner to clean it up. Fines are applied if the property owner ignores the initial request to clean up.
