## Budget Submissions 2019/2020

Council is currently inviting submissions for the coming 2019/2020 Budget. Submissions will be accepted until the 30th April 19 for the financial year commencing 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019. Council generally adopts the 2019/2020 Budget at a special meeting of Council taking place in early July.

Submissions must include a detailed description, if appropriate detailed plans and an estimated cost, if known, of the project and other funding that has been received or is being applied for to deliver the project. ### CEACA Seniors Housing Project.

With funding from the State Government secured, construction of 71 two-bedroom units across CEACA's 11 Member Councils is now well underway with construction in some locations to be completed in the first quarter of 2019.

These units are being designed to reduce falls and accidents, allowing older people to remain living safely in their own homes and communities for longer.

CEACA's Senior Housing Project has been greenlit to deliver the following outcomes:

- 1) Keep older people living in rural communities for longer through the provision of appropriate and affordable housing options.
- 2) Stimulate economic and employment growth via the construction and management of assets and provision of aged care services.
- 3) Create an asset base and cash flow that can be leveraged for the ongoing growth of community housing in the region.
- 4) Deliver efficient health and support services to the ageing community.
