Pregnant Women (any trimester)

Persons 65years and older

Aboriginal People 6mths - 4yr or 15yrs & over

All children Aged 6mths - 4years

Individuals aged 6 months & over with medical conditions that place them at risk for complications of influenza, namely: Cardiac disease, chronic illnesses requiring regular medical follow-up or hospitalisation in the preceding year, Chronic neurological conditions, people with impaired immunity, children aged 6mths - 10years (receiving long term aspirin Therapy)

The construction crew have completed works on the M040 with bitumen seals and re-seals finalised this week. Small sections of seal were also carried out on Cement and Diorite Streets.

The crew will be mobilising to the North end of Echo Valley Road to commence a 4km gravel re-sheet and bend realignment.
